

**EVESHAM TOWNSHIP DRINKING WATER IS FREE FROM**  
**PFOA, PFOS, AND PFNA**

The Evesham Municipal Utilities Authority (MUA) has been receiving calls regarding a news story released March 6, 2023, addressing contamination of drinking water in neighboring communities for what are known as “forever chemicals.” Beginning in 2020, Evesham MUA has monitored and tested for forever chemicals, specifically perfluorononanoic acid (PFNA), perfluorooctanoic acid (PFOA), and perfluorooctanesulfonic acid (PFOS) at all our drinking water sources. Periodic monitoring has continued to this date. These chemicals have not been detected at any of our drinking water sources. We will continue to monitor our drinking water for the presence of these chemicals along with any other hazardous compounds that could negatively affect the health and safety of our residents.
