

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

Availability of Monitoring Data for Unregulated Contaminants for

EVESHAM MUA PWS ID #0313001

Every 5 years, the US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) issues a list of no more than 30 unregulated contaminants to be monitored by public water systems. Unregulated contaminants are those that don't yet have a drinking water standard set by the US EPA. The purpose of monitoring these contaminants is to help EPA decide whether the contaminants should have a standard. Our water system has sampled for a series of unregulated contaminants under EPA's 5th Unregulated Contaminant Monitoring Rule (UCMR5). The UCMR5 contaminants included 29 PFAS compounds and lithium.

Evesham MUA collected two samples at each of our 9 Treatment points between 2024 and 2025 and all results were below the reporting limits for all 30 contaminants. The MUA was also required to collect from the interconnections with NJAWC and Mt. Laurel MUA on a quarterly basis in 2024. PFHxA and PFPeA, both of which are currently unregulated with no enforceable limits, had detections on samples collected on 11/4/24 at Mt Laurel's interconnect but were not detected in the other 3 quarters. All other samples in 2024 were not detected for any of the contaminants at the interconnections.
